

**Will County Fair Power Wheels Derby Entry Form**  
**Friday, August 24, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.**  
**Saturday, August 25, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.**

**Rules:**

- Any regular electric Power Wheel is allowed. No 4-wheeler type vehicles allowed. Child's legs must be in a compartment. Ride in the Power Wheels, not ride on!
- Kids 3 – 8 years of age are eligible to participate. There are two age groups: 3 - 5 and 6 - 8.
- Helmets must be worn.
- Power Wheels must have seat belts or other driver safety restraints.
- The vehicle is allowed to have UP TO a 12-volt lawn mower battery, which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat and battery must be secured and sealed away from the child.
- All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties, duct tape, another flexible product for making them stay shut.
- Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking.
- Motor must remain stock. The only modification allowed is using a lawn mower battery.
- You can add decorations like headers, etc. but they cannot reinforce the car.

**Payouts:** Payouts are as follows for **Power Wheels derby** age group:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place – 5 carnival tickets + trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 4 carnival tickets + ribbon
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 3 carnival tickets + ribbon
- 4<sup>th</sup> place – 2 carnival tickets + ribbon

**If running Power Wheels derby on both dates, 2 separate forms MUST be submitted.** There is **no fee entry** for Power Wheels derby, however, participants and parents must pay **\$4 fair admission fee** (if applicable due to age).

Only two adults may accompany the participant into the track area for the derby at no cost. Any additional adults wishing to enter the track area must pay the **pit pass fee of \$15**. Pit pass access is limited to those individuals age 16 and up. Visitors are always welcome to view the Power Wheels derby from the fair grandstands with a **grandstand ticket purchase**. Due to insurance and fair policies, the participant and accompanying parents must immediately vacate the premises following the event for the demolition derby to be held. The Power Wheels must be immediately removed from the track area as well.
